<b>Description</b>	This is a unilateral declaration by the PKK's 12th Party Congress held May 5-7, 2025, announcing the dissolution of the PKK's organizational structure and cessation of 40 years of armed struggle against the Turkish state. The Congress concluded that the PKK has achieved its historical mission of establishing the Kurdish issue as resolvable through democratic politics, and therefore voted to end all activities under the PKK name. The declaration designates imprisoned PKK leader Abdullah Öcalan to lead the implementation of this transition from armed conflict to democratic political engagement, and calls upon Turkish authorities to provide legal guarantees, recognize Öcalan's right to democratic politics, enable constitutional reforms, release political prisoners, and engage in constructive dialogue to build a democratic society based on principles of equality, common homeland, and democratic nationhood for Kurds within Turkey. While unilateral in form, the document is part of a broader set of concessions and confidence-building measures arranged with the Turkish state, and should be understood as reciprocated.
