- 1. Act as depositaries and witnesses to the agreements reached.
- 2. To have a permanent presence at the Peace Dialogues Table according to availability.
- 3. Provide political support to the development of the Peace Dialogues Table and implementation of the agreements.
- 4. Provide recommendations for the development of the agenda and the process at the request of both parties.
- 5. Promote compliance with the agreements between the parties.
- 6. To protect the development of the Peace Dialogues Table.
- 7. In the case of being required by the parties, accompany the transfer of delegations as available.
- 8. Maintain bilateral relations with the two parties.
- 9. Provide good offices in times of crisis or dispute.
- 10. Support the dialogue and implementation process and cooperate with technical and/or economic assistance in areas identified by the parties according to their capacities.
- 11. Engage with other representatives of the international community to strengthen support for the Peace Dialogues Table and implementation of the agreements.
- 12. Other responsibilities at the request of both parties upon acceptance.
