

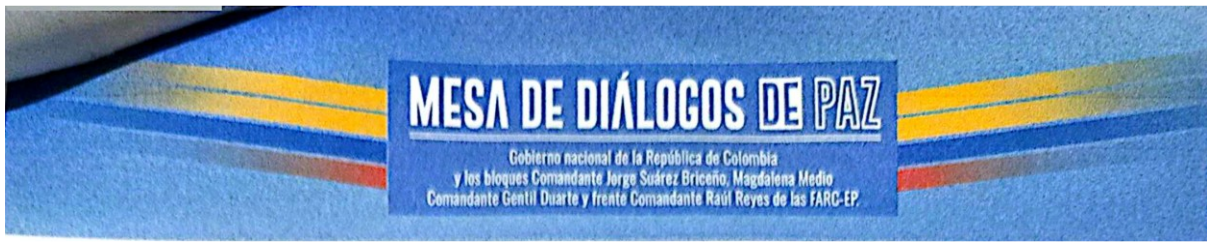
AGREEMENT ON TERRITORIAL TRANSFORMATIONS AND LAND

VII CYCLE, AGREEMENT No. 1 Campo Hermoso, November 17, 2025.

The Peace Dialogue Table between the National Government of the Republic of Colombia and the General Staff of the Blocs Commander Jorge Suárez Briceño, Magdalena Medio Commander Gentil Duarte and Commander Raúl Reyes Front of the FARC-EP, meeting in Campo Hermoso inspection station, municipality of San Vicente del Caguán, department of Caquetá, on 17 November 2025, in the presence of the International Community, the World Council of Churches and the Colombian Episcopal Conference, agrees:

The MDP:

1. Will support the National Land Agency (ANT) in the land survey and titling of vacant land available for allocation by the Nation in the Amazon Belt, in order to strengthen legal security and dignified permanence for rural families.
2. Will support communities in their efforts to establish Peasant Reserve Areas (ZRC), consolidate Sustainable Development Plans as essential instruments for the peasant economy, rural land use planning and conservation of ecosystems.
3. Will promote the consolidation of Food Protection and Production Areas (APPA) as determining factors in rural land use. Other organisational structures will also be taken into account.
4. Will manage the creation of an environmental and agricultural fund aimed at developing forest restoration, bioeconomy and/or sustainable production projects that strengthen the livelihoods of rural communities in areas of special environmental interest.
5. Will strengthen the implementation of territorial transformation projects aimed at communities in the territories where the EMBF of the FARC-EP is present, managed by the MDP.
6. Will support the management of the Rural Development Agency (ADR) with communities in the territories.
7. Will make a series of visits to the Amazon Belt, Catatumbo, Antioquia and Sur de Bolívar, where communities have created agreements for territorial transformation, to hold a dialogue on the status and routes for implementing what has been agreed.



The MDP agrees to establish a thematic commission on land and territories, which will define and promote a work plan and roadmap establishing the strategies, mechanisms, and instruments necessary to make progress on issues such as unproductive large estates, Law 2 of 1959, foreign ownership of land in Colombia, legal aspects of UAFs, and formalisation of land and urban property.

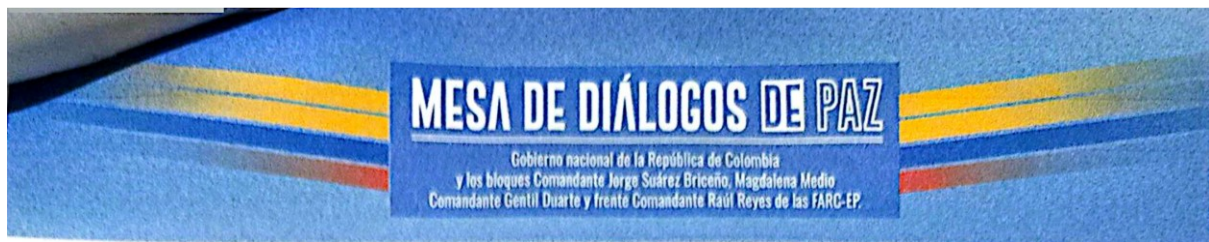
