**Agreement between KajoKeji Community and Ground Force, Battalion 2,
KajoKeji Area on the resolutions on civil – military relations**

Preamble

We the representative of the Community of KajoKeji and Ground Force, Battalion 2, KajoKeji Area, having deliberated on civil – Military relations and addressed our differences during a dialogue facilitated by Community Empowerment Progress Organization (CEPO) from Monday 3rd to Wednesday 5th April 2023 in KajoKeji town, do hereby agree on the following resolutions and recommendations

Resolution No. 1

The KajoKeji community and the Ground Force, Battalion 2, KajoKeji Area, have forgiven themselves on the civil – Military differences

Resolution No. 2

The KajoKeji community and the Ground Force, Battalion 2, KajoKeji Area, will live in harmony respecting one another as citizen with different responsibilities in accordance to the interim constitution of the Republic of South Sudan

Resolution No. 3

The Ground Force, Battalion 2, KajoKeji Area, shall adhere to the SSPDF act in all their activities as shall protect the community without any harassment and intimidation in accordance to the interim constitution of the Republic of South Sudan.

Resolution No. 4

The leadership of the Ground Force, Battalion 2, KajoKeji Area, shall take appropriate disciplinary measures on officers and NCO's who will commit crime in the community such as killing, rape etc.

Resolution No. 5

Any community members commit any crime shall be dealt with in accordance with laws of the Republic of South Sudan

Resolution No. 6

The KajoKeji community members will cooperate with Ground Force, Battalion 2, KajoKeji Area, and Organized forces in matters of their safety and report any suspected or incident of criminal nature to the relevant authorities in KajoKeji county.

Resolution No. 7

The Ground Force, Battalion 2, KajoKeji Area, shall remove cattle from in KajoKeji County.

Resolution No. 8

All those who committed crimes should be brought to Justice

Resolution No. 9

The KajoKeji Community and Ground Force, Battalion 2, KajoKeji Area, shall hence forth build trust and confidence between themselves

Resolution No. 10

The State and County authority should continue to dialogue the neighboring communities in the Republic of Uganda on matters of boundary and land grabbing.

Resolution No. 11

The Army should protect the territorial boundaries of the Government of the Republic of South Sudan

Resolution No. 12

The State and County authority should deploy police forces to all the Payams in KajoKeji County.

Resolution No. 13

The State and County authority should ensure that the county judiciary system including court martial should be functional in KajoKeji County

Resolution No. 14

The County authority should ensure rehabilitation and construction of feeder roads for easy connection to the county headquarters, hospital and market place etc.

Resolution No. 15

The County authority should ensure improvement of network service in KajoKeji County and beyond

Resolution No. 16

The KajoKeji community members and Ground Force, Battalion 2, KajoKeji Area, will impact on individual and group farming for food production and that they should be supported technically and financially.

Resolution No. 17

The marriage customs, tradition and culture of KajoKeji Community should be respected by all in KajoKeji County

Resolution No. 18

The church shall immediately launch the implementation of the agreement

Resolution No. 19

The Ground Force, Battalion 2, KajoKeji Area and KajoKeji community will engage themselves in sport for peace activities.

Resolution No. 20

The county authority shall ensure that all Payam administrators are deployed to their work place accordingly

Resolution No. 21

The county authority shall ensure the rehabilitation and construction of all Payam headquarters

Resolution No. 22

The agreement shall be disseminated by KajoKeji joint Peace Committee known as KKJPC

Resolution No. 23

That the agreement shall be disseminated to the community and Ground Force, Battalion 2, KajoKeji Area through media and civic awareness

Resolution No. 24

That the church is requested to dialogue with the none signatories in KajoKeji Area for possible peace and reconciliation initiative

Resolution No. 25

That the church shall monitor the implementation of the agreement and shall meet and consolidate with parties to the agreement

Resolution No. 26

That we commit ourselves to adhere to the agreement and shall not violate it whatsoever.

RECOMMENDATION

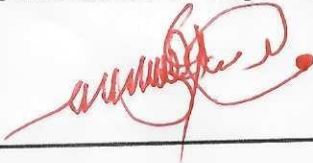
1. The meeting recommended that there shall be a continues dialogue between The KajoKeji community and Ground Force, Battalion 2, KajoKeji Area
2. The meeting recommended that the Salaries of Army, organized forces and civil servants be increased.
3. The meeting recommended that the process of army unification be expedite to avoid un necessary creation of affiliated armed groups
4. The meeting recommended that the army should be supported with foot and other necessary service
5. The meeting recommended that the military and organized be provided with vehicles
6. The meeting recommended that matrix shall be developed by joint peace committee for the implementation of the agreement.

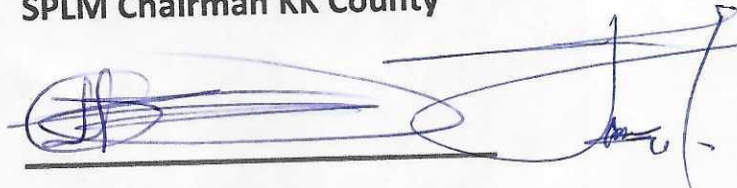
