RESOLUTION NO.1 COMPOSITION OF THE INTERIM CEASEFIRE HONITORING COMMITTEE AND ASSIGNED TASKS AND FUNCTIONS

WHEREAS, the Interim Coasefire Agreement has been signed by Government of the Republic of the Philippines (GRP) - Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) Sub-Committees on Cossation of Hostilities on 27 January 1997:

the GRP - MILF Technical Committee agreed to the WHEREAS. creation of an independent monitoring committee in their meeting on 25-27 February 1997;

WHEREAS, a joint meeting of the Sub-Committees on Committees on Committe

MOW. THEREFORE, the Sub-Committees on Cessation of Hostilities of the GRP and the MILF hereby resolve the following:

- 1. The formation and immediate convening of an independent monitoring committee which shall henceforth be called the Interim Ceasefire Monitoring Committee (ICHC).
- 2. The composition of the Interim Ceasefire Monitoring Committee shall be as follows:
 - a) Representative of Notre Dame University (NDU)
- b) Representative of Haguindanaon Professionals and Employ-association (MAPEA), Inc. c) Representative of Protestant Lawyers League of the Philees Association
- ippines (PLLP)
- d) Representative of Cotabato City Hedia Multi-Purpose Cooperative (CCMPC).
- 3. Letters of invitation will be served to the above-mentioned organizations/institutions for their availability and acceptance.
- The NDU representative shall act as Chairman of the Interim Cossefire Monitoring Committee, with the MAPEA representative as Vice Chairman.
- 5. The Interim Coasefire Monitoring Committee shall function under the following terms:
- a) Conduct fact-finding inquiries on matters referred to it the CRP and MILF Sub-Committees on Cessation of Hostilities pertaining to elleged violations/infractions of the provisions of the Interim Ceasefire Agreement entered into by both Sub-Committees on January 27, 1987. Referrals shall be made after the other party is duly informed of the matter submitted for inquiry, and the same is not resolved by the Sub-Committees thereof.
- b) Issue appropriate letters of invitation to persons whose declarations/statements may shed light on matters under consideration by the Interim Ceasefire Monitoring Committee.
- c) Coordinate with other offices and/or organizations may be necessary in the exercise of its functions/tasks.
- d) Prepare and submit reports duly supported by appropriate evidence on matters which may be referred to it by the GRP and the MILF Sub-Committees on Consation of Hostilities.



- e) Conduct its inquiries and submit reports to the GRP and the MILF Sub-Committees of Cossation of Hostilities with utmost dispatch.
- f) All reports and proceedings of the Interim Ceasefire Manitoring Committee shall be considered classified. No part of it nor information thereof maybe divulged to anyone, except by the authorized official spokespersons of the GEP and the MILF as provided for in the Administrative Proceedures in the Conduct of GEP-MILF Technical Committee Heetings adopted on February 26, 1997.
- g) Additional membership to the Interim Ceasefire Monitoring Committee maybe made upon Joint approval by the GRF and the .MILF Sub-Committees on Ceasation of Hostilities.
- h) The Interim Ceesefire Monitoring Committee shall adopt such internal procedures as maybe appropriate to enable it to expeditiously perform its tasks and subsit the same to the GRP and MILF Sub-Committees on Cessation of Hostilities for its joint notation and approval.
- i) The Interim Coasefire Monitoring Committee may employ the expertise of certain disinterested persons or organizations in the pursuance of its assigned tasks.
- j) Perform such other acts as maybe jointly determined to be recessary by the GRP and the MILF Sub-Counittees on Cessation of Hostilities for the accomplishment of its tasks/functions.
- The GRP and the MILF shall, within its capabilities, provide administrative support to the Interin Ceasefire Honitoring Committee in the performance of its functions.
- 7. The two Sub-Committees on Cessation of Hostilities shall submit the points of agreement in this joint meeting for final confirmation and approval to the Third Meeting of the Technical Committee of the GRP and the HILF on April 9-10. 1997 at the Eutre Dame University in Cotabato City.
